Dr. Michael Rachlis was born in Winnipeg, Manitoba in 1951 and graduated from the University medical school in 1975. He interned at McMaster University and then practiced family medicine at the South Riverdale Community Health Centre in Toronto for eight years. He completed training in Geriatric Medicine at McMaster and was made a fellow of the Canadian Royal College of Physicians in 1981.

Dr. Rachlis has lectured widely on health care issues. He has been invited to make presentations to committees of the Canadian House of Commons and the Canadian Senate as well as the United States House of Representatives and Senate. He is a frequent media commentator on health policy issues and the author of three national bestsellers about Canada's health care system. In his spare time, Dr. Rachlis enjoys cycling and duplicate bridge.
