YOUR PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER or WALK-IN CLINIC



SEEK IMMEDIATE CARE IF:

I CAN'T ACCESS OTHER CARE OPTIONS

I'M VERY WORRIED or

Fever — 38°C (100.4°F) or higher:

- infants less than 3 months old
- children with immune system problems or complex chronic health problems
- · child is very sleepy or difficult to wake despite fever medicine

Breathing problems:

- working hard to breathe, breathing faster than normal, pale skin, blue lips
- · asthma not responding to usual puffers

Dehydration:

- repeated vomiting and unable to keep any fluids in
- dry mouth
- no urine more than 8 hours



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Children and youth with more serious illness are always treated first. Those with less urgent needs may have much longer wait times.
